Barbara L. Carnefix Memorial Scholarship Fund

For graduates of Fruitland High School enrolled full-time to study Business.

Boise Branch, American Association of University Women Inez Robb Scholarship Fund

For female degree-seeking juniors and seniors at BSU.

Caldwell Memorial Hospital Employees and Friends Health Services Scholarship Fund

Established by the employees and friends of Caldwell Memorial Hospital, this scholarship provides financial assistance to students, primarily in the original Hospital's service area, that are interested in pursuing a degree or certificate in a health care field.
