

# Need Help Paying for Child Care?



Talk with Jane Greybell with the Idaho Childcare Program (ICCP) to see about getting reduced or free childcare. Her number is 686-1931.

Eligibility is based on:

- **Income:** To be eligible, a family's income must meet [ICCP income limits](#).
- **Family size:** The amount a family is eligible for also depends on number of people in the family.
- **Activity:** ICCP will cover part of the costs for child care only while parents are working, attending school or attending approved activities. The number of childcare hours ICCP will help pay for is arranged between the parents and the case worker.

ICCP gross maximum income limits:

- **\$1,356 for household of 2.**
- **\$1,706 for household of 3.**
- **\$2,056 for household of 4.**
- **\$2,406 for household of 5.**
- **\$2,756 for household of 6.**
- **\$3,106 for household of 7.**
- **\$3,456 for household of 8.**
- **\$3,806 for household of 9.**
- **\$4,156 for household of 10.**

Also, if ICCP does turn you down we have a program called the Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) that allows for a sliding scale fee to be used for tribal members. Bring in your denial letter from ICCP and Brenda will be able to get you set up with the CCDF.

Eligibility is based on:

- **Income:** To be eligible, a family's income must meet [CCDF income limits](#)
- **Family size:** The amount a family is eligible for also depends on number of people in the family.
- **Activity:** CCDF will cover part of the costs for child care only while parents are working, attending school or attending approved activities. The number of childcare hours CCDF will help pay for is arranged between the parents and the case worker.
- **Enrollment:** To be eligible, a family must be part of a federally recognized tribe.

CCDF gross maximum income limits:

- **\$2,527 for household of 2.**
- **\$3,122 for household of 3.**
- **\$3,717 for household of 4.**
- **\$4,311 for household of 5.**
- **\$4,906 for household of 6.**
- **\$5,017 for household of 7.**
- **\$5,129 for household of 8.**
