Dear Interested Party:

The Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) and the Coeur d'Alene Tribe (Tribe) have prepared a Record of Decision (ROD) in preparation for developing the Tribe's first Integrated Resource Management Plan (IRMP) for Tribal natural, environmental and cultural resources. The Coeur d'Alene Reservation is located in northern Idaho. This IRMP ROD selects from four alternatives, the management alternative that protects the natural and cultural environment of the Coeur d'Alene Reservation while supporting overall social and economic needs. Based on a thorough review of the alternatives, the potential environmental impacts, and the comments received from the public, Tribal members and federal, state and local agencies, Alternative B is adopted for implementation through the IRMP.

The BIA and Coeur d'Alene Tribe are sending you this letter in addition to a copy of the IRMP Record of Decision. 
