Tour attendees met at the Tensed Community Center at 10 am and then proceeded to the Tensed City Park to start the tour at the north end of the proposed trail. The tour proceeded southward along the proposed trail alignment to Hangman Creek. Mr. Lamb and Mr. McCracken pointed out culvert locations and access areas. Mr. Lamb also pointed out that all construction access should be along the western side of the 20-foot wide trail easement in order to avoid impacts to adjacent non-Tribal properties. Following the walk along the northern part of the trail alignment, the attendees drove to the DeSmet road to view the southern end of the trail, particularly the farm vehicle access.

Questions and Responses:

Mr. Ken Waxler of S&S Contracting asked where water would be available for use on the project, specifically for dust control and compaction. Mr. Lamb indicated that he would check on this and put the findings in an addendum.

The tour concluded at approximately 11:30am.
