

Tribal License Requirements and Fee Schedule

The establishment of licensing policies and procedures for persons fishing or hunting on the Coeur d'Alene Reservation is pursuant to Coeur d'Alene Tribal Code Chapter 20.

Any person engaging in hunting and fishing shall have a license on his/her person when engaged in such activity, and shall display the license for inspection upon the request of any commissioned Conservation Officer or other duly commissioned officer. The following licensing requirements apply:

All hunting and yearly fishing licenses are valid through December 31st of the calendar year that it was sold

Coeur d'Alene Tribal Member: Must carry Tribal identification card.

Resident Non-member Indian: Must carry a Tribal license in order to engage in any hunting or fishing activities (includes designated hunting).

There is a 1-year residency requirement prior to issuance of license. All persons 13 and under must be accompanied by a licensed adult. Must carry Tribal identification card

Non-Indians: All persons 14 and over must carry a Tribal license to hunt and fish anywhere within the boundaries of the Reservation. In addition a State license is required to hunt within the boundaries of the Reservation (fees and regulations follow). All persons 13 and under must be accompanied by a licensed adult.
