**SALE OF TIMBER**  
**2023 Allotment 166 Cutting Permit**  
**COEUR D'ALENE INDIAN RESERVATION**

Sealed bids in duplicate, on forms provided therefor, available from Coeur d'Alene Tribal Forestry, marked outside "Proposal for Timber, 2022 Allotment 166 Cutting Permit", will be received until 10:00 A.M. local time on April 12, 2023 at the Tribal Forestry Office. Bids will be opened at the Coeur d'Alene Tribal Forestry Office, 402 Anne Antelope Avenue, Plummer, Idaho. For sale is a 12-acre tract of timber within the Coeur d'Alene Indian Reservation within Allotment 166. The logging unit is located in portions of Section 25, Township 46 North, Range 6 West, Boise Meridian, Benewah County, Idaho.

Approximately 12 acres will be logged with an estimated volume of 57 thousand board feet (57 MBF) of sawlogs. The minimum acceptable bids and estimated amounts are:

- **\$170/MBF for 30 MBF of ponderosa pine sawlogs**
- **\$240/00/MBF for 27 MBF of Douglas-fir and Other Species sawlogs**
- **\$25.00/TON for an unestimated amount of Mixed Fir Species tonwood (non-biddable/removal optional)**

Bidders will also have the option to purchase an undetermined amount of all species pulp logs not meeting the above specifications at a flat rate of \$2.00 per ton. No bids are allowed on tonwood and pulp logs. All timber must be cut and paid for by October 31, 2023.

Each bidder must state the price per thousand board feet, Scribner Decimal C Log Rule using standard taper rules, which will be paid for timber cut and scaled. Only bids from companies that have a current Coeur d'Alene Tribal Business license will be accepted and a fully signed copy of such license must be submitted with the bid proposal.

Deposits in the form of a cashier's check payable to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, in the amount of \$1,000.00 must accompany each sealed bid. The deposit of the apparent high bidder and of others who submit written requests to have their bids considered for acceptance will be retained pending acceptance or rejection of bids. All other deposits will be returned following the completion of the bidding. The deposit of the successful bidder will be applied as part of the purchase price against timber cut on this sale only, or retained as liquidated damages if the bidder fails to execute the contract and furnish a satisfactory performance bond in the amount of \$1,000 within thirty (30) days of the acceptance of the bid. An acceptable performance bond will be in the form of a cashier's check, Irrevocable Letter of Credit or other form acceptable to the Superintendent.

Permittee shall pay the total value within 15 days of invoicing to the Coeur d'Alene BIA, Coeur d'Alene Agency, Dept. C112, P.O. Box 979121, St Louis, MO 63197-9000.

The right to waive technical defects and to reject any or all bids is reserved. Before bids are submitted, full information concerning the timber, conditions of the sale, and submission of bids should be obtained from Barbara Scaroni at Coeur d'Alene Tribal Forestry, P. O.
