



Native Voter Frequently Asked Questions

How can I check if I am registered to vote?

You can check on the following websites:

- Washington: <https://www.sos.wa.gov/elections>

Can I register to vote online?

The deadline to register to vote online in Idaho has passed but you can still register AND vote on election day, November 5th. Or you can go to your county elections department site and register and vote in-person.

What do I need to register and vote?

1. Photo ID (license or tribal ID); and
2. Proof of physical residence dated a minimum of 30 days prior (see your state websites for valid forms of documentation)

Can I still vote absentee?

The last day to request an absentee ballot in Idaho is **Friday, October 25th**. Absentee ballots must be submitted (postmarked if by mail) before or on Tuesday, Nov 5th.

Can I get a tribal ID to use for the elections?

Yes, you can go to Tribal Enrollment department to get or update your ID to use as a valid photo, however it can only be used for proof of physical residence if issued 30 days PRIOR to NOV 5th.

Can I register and vote as a former felon?

Yes, you are eligible to register and vote if you have completed all the terms of your probation and have paid all your fees.

Can I help my family member or friend register to vote?

Yes, in Idaho you can help them register and vote in-person at the county elections office or at the polls on Election Day, November 5th.

Can I get transportation assistance to the polls?
